Note E: Professional Interview

Those applying for Chartered Membership will be required to attend a professional interview that will be conducted by senior members of the Society.

Full details of the format of this interview will be sent to candidates when they are invited to attend.

Note F: Payment of Fees

The subscription fee is payable to the Society on an annual basis.

Annual subscriptions become due on 1st January. You will be informed of the amount due prior to the start of the year.

Please check your application carefully to ensure that all sections are completed in full and that all documentation is secure. If you have any queries concerning your application for membership, please do not hesitate to contact the Membership Committee at the Secretariat.

In, all cases of professional class, the applicant shall be required to submit in addition to a CV, a professional practice report to the Education and Admission Committee. The applicant must have reached the age of 25 years.

A person who has reached 40 years, holds, and has held an acceptable position in connection with Waste Management for a minimum of five years can apply as a mature applicant.

FELLOW

- Chartered Member who has a membership standing of minimum 5 years and has shown evidence of distinguished professional attainment in Waste Management.

CHARTERED MEMBER

- Post graduate or First Degree or its equivalent holder in Waste Management, Environmental Engineering or Pollution Control (from School approved by the National Council) and has a minimum of 2 year relevant continuous experience in Waste Management.
- Any Degree or its equivalent or a post graduate qualification with a minimum of 5 years continuous experience in Waste Management and has undergone a programme of structured training of the Society.
- Associate Member with a minimum of 2 years continuous experience in Waste Management and has undergone structured training of the society.

ASSOCIATE MEMBER

- Graduate member of the Society for a minimum of 2 years and has undergone structured training as determined by the National Council.
- A professional member of a relevant profession and has a minimum of 2 years relevant continuous experience in Waste Management.

TECHNICIAN MEMBER

- Relevant Certificate or National Diploma holder that has a minimum of 3 years relevant continuous experience in Waste Management, including structured training as determined by the National Council.

GRADUATE MEMBER

- Any person who is concerned with Waste Management and has a Degree (or its equivalent) in relevant discipline.
- Student Member upon graduation and Obtaining an approved Degree (or its equivalent).

STUDENT MEMBER

- Student not less than 16 years of age who is undertaking a course of study and examination relevant to Waste Management.

HONORARY FELLOW

- A person who has rendered notable service to Wastes Management /the society or a person of distinction with a concern for the environment.
